Can I Take Pre-Admission Content Tests (PACT)?

Policy updates effective March 7, 2013, allow individuals who have never been admitted to an Educator Preparation Program (EPP) to take Pre-Admission Content Tests (PACT) to demonstrate content proficiency for possible admission into an EPP in Texas. **Taking PACT does not ensure admittance into a program.** EPPs may have additional admission requirements. Answer the questions below to see if you qualify to take PACT.

9. Are You Ready to Register for PACT?

You can register on the ETS TEXES website at **www.texes.ets.org**.

- Click on "Register" at the top of the page.
- Read the explanation under "Online Registration System New Users."
- After you have read the explanation, click on "New User" at the bottom of the page.
- Select "no TEA ID>>" if you do not have an existing Educator Profile in the Texas Education Agency (TEA) system.
- Confirm your registration as a PACT participant by selecting "pre-admission content tests (PACT)>>"
- Enter personal information for a testing account to be created in the ETS
 TEXES system as well as the TEA system. Certify graduation from an
 accredited college or university. (See the link provided if you are unsure of
 your college or university's accreditation.)
- Enter the requested supplemental information on the screen that follows.
- Create a username and password and enter a password reminder that can be used by a customer service representative if you forget your password.
- Because you are a PACT candidate, you do not need to create an Educator Profile on the TEA website in order to register for a test. The ETS online registration system will transfer the data you enter to the TEA system and give you a TEA ID number. Be sure to make a note of your TEA ID and Username.
- Select "Register for a test" if you are ready to do so.

Before the day of the test, you should read and be familiar with all policies and procedures in the *Registration Bulletin* for the test you are planning to take. *Registration Bulletins* can be downloaded from the ETS TEXES website at **www.texes.ets.org**.
