AUGUST 2011

Texas Examinations for Master Teachers™ (TExMaT™)

- The Master Science Teacher (MST) EC–6 (093) test will not be offered in September 2011. All references to the MST EC–6 (093) test have been removed from the *Bulletin*. Test takers should continue to take the MST EC–4 (090) test.

NOVEMBER 2011

The following was added to the Test Center Procedures and Regulations

- ETS reserves the right to take appropriate action and/or notify appropriate authorities including, but not limited to, law enforcement authorities, if a test taker responds in a threatening or disturbing way to essay or speaking questions or communicates with ETS either verbally or in writing in a threatening or disturbing manner.

DECEMBER 2011

The exception to the Identification (ID) Requirements regarding political asylum and refugee status was changed to the following:

Unable to Meet ID Requirements

If you have been granted political asylum, have refugee status or are otherwise unable to meet the identification requirements, you **must** contact the ETS Office of Testing Integrity (OTI) at least **7 days before** registering to test. You must receive approval from OTI before you may register. You should also be prepared to submit any requested documents to OTI for review prior to receiving approval. If you do not contact OTI before you register, and as a result you are not permitted to test or your test scores are withheld, your test fees will not be refunded.
